

Declaration of Intent

Bay County General Jural Assembly

Bay County, Michigan

Date: June 15, 2025

1. We, the people of Bay County, Michigan—*acting in our sovereign capacity as free individuals*, and *in peaceable assembly*—hereby declare our lawful intent to organize and operate as the **Bay County General Jural Assembly** (hereafter the “Assembly”).

2. We assert the following legal and natural principles:

- **Sovereignty resides with the people:** We affirm that all governmental authority originates from and is held by the free people, not delegated to or dependent on state assemblies or military bodies.
- **Right to self-govern:** We invoke our unalienable rights—including the right to assemble, govern ourselves, and hold public trust—under the Declaration of Independence, the Constitution, and natural law.
- **County as foundation of government:** We recognize the county as the original jurisdiction where local governance is grounded and closest to the people we serve.

3. The Assembly’s purpose is to:

1. Redeem and hold in trust the **Sovereign Executive Authority in Trust (SEAT)** for the people of Bay County.
2. Facilitate true self-governance through ordinary people meeting in lawful assembly.
3. Provide a transparent mechanism through which official acts—such as legal notices, ordinances, claims of jurisdiction, and administration of trust—are conducted publicly and responsibly.

4. We affirm that:

- This Assembly does **not** require membership in any state body or reliance on state-held authority.
- It is a **de jure** governance structure rooted in our natural and common-law foundation.
- We claim and exercise lawful standing through **notice, publication, and peaceful occupation** of our county’s sovereign authority.

5. The Sovereign Executive Authority in Trust (SEAT) will be explicitly defined, transferred into a **County Trust**, and operated as follows:

- **Trust Declaration:** A formal document will declare that SEAT is held *in trust* for the people of Bay County, exclusively for purposes that protect our rights, property, and community.
- **Trust Officers:** Trust administration will be overseen by individuals in defined roles (e.g., Trustees, Notaries, Clerk of the Assembly) selected openly by the Assembly.
- **Public Oversight:** All trust activities will be recorded, archived, and made available for public review to foster transparency and accountability.

6. The Assembly hereby resolves to:

- **Organize regular gatherings**, using peaceful, orderly procedures to discuss county concerns, adopt community resolutions, and take lawful action.
- **File public notices** in local papers, county journals, or online forums stating our intent, meeting times, and formal claims of jurisdiction.
- **Record minutes and decisions** in a County Trust record book or registry to preserve official legal documentation under common-law standards.

7. We expect and serve to fulfill these obligations for the benefit of Bay County's people—not to exercise authority over others, but to restore lawful self-determination and re-establish accountability in local governance.

8. We reject any requirement to gain sanction, recognition, or hierarchical approval from a state assembly, military body, or other higher-level authority. We rely solely on our lawful foundation and real-time exercise of local sovereignty.

9. We will maintain a public-facing presence—such as a website or public forum—showing all trust documents, assembly records, and governance actions as freely accessible to all citizens of Bay County.

10. This Declaration of Intent conforms to the founding principles of the United States and Michigan: that government legitimacy derives from the people, acting in assemblies, and that unalienable rights are inherent—not granted.
